- Exhibited leadership in his/her own personal development as well as the growth of others.
- Demonstrated commitment, understanding and action that support the goals and values of ACUI.
- Must be a current undergraduate or graduate student in good standing at his/her ACUI member institution.

Requirements:

- Complete Nomination Form (name, title, institution, address, phone, email, fax/Nominator name, title, institution, address, phone email, relation to nominee)
- Keeping the criteria in mind, please respond to the following questions:
- Describe how the candidate dedicates herself/himself to the ideals of the college union/student activities field.
- Explain how the candidate's volunteer and leadership experience and unselfish giving impact the region and the college union/student activities field in working with staff, students and community organizations.
- What character strengths distinguish this candidate from others?
- Why does this candidate deserve to receive this award?
